

Madison Rose Society List of Recommended Roses

The following list of roses are those that members of the Madison Rose Society feel do well in this area. Some of the shrubs do not require winter protection, but most require some protection. All of these roses are rated on a scale of zero to ten by the American Rose Society with 10 being the highest.

Color classifications are as follows: ab – apricot & apricot blend; dr – dark red; dp – deep pink; dy – deep yellow; lp – light pink; ly – light yellow; m – mauve & mauve blends; mp – medium pink; mr – medium red; my – medium yellow; ob – orange & orange blend; op – orange-pink & orange-pink blend; or – orange-red & orange-red blend; pb – pink blend; rb – red blend; r – russet; w – white, near white & white blend; yb – yellow blend

Some of these shrubs may require a little winter protection, but even if they die back in a severe winter, they will come back. Protection usually consists of some straw, marsh hay, bark mulch, or oak leaves around the base. If they are grafted plants, we would suggest that the crown be covered with dirt, if it is above ground.
